- 3. Anne Lynch **Treasurer's Report:** \$16,687 income less \$11,383 expenses = \$5,304 net surplus, seconded by Joan Quinn.
- 4. Aaron Thredgold GUEST SPEAKER Mount Helena Volunteer Bushfire Brigade
- DFES, MHVBFB, Shire of Mundaring & Mt Helena residents all play a connected role in bush fire prevention.
- Mt Helena is a bushfire prone area.
- Getting prepared: Shire's fuel break and load advice; bushfire risk treatment standards; fire rating system (under review due to complaints, expected by this summer);
